A useful tool for testing the effectiveness of remedies or supplements, or imparting specific frequencies to a matrix like water, oils, or other materials.

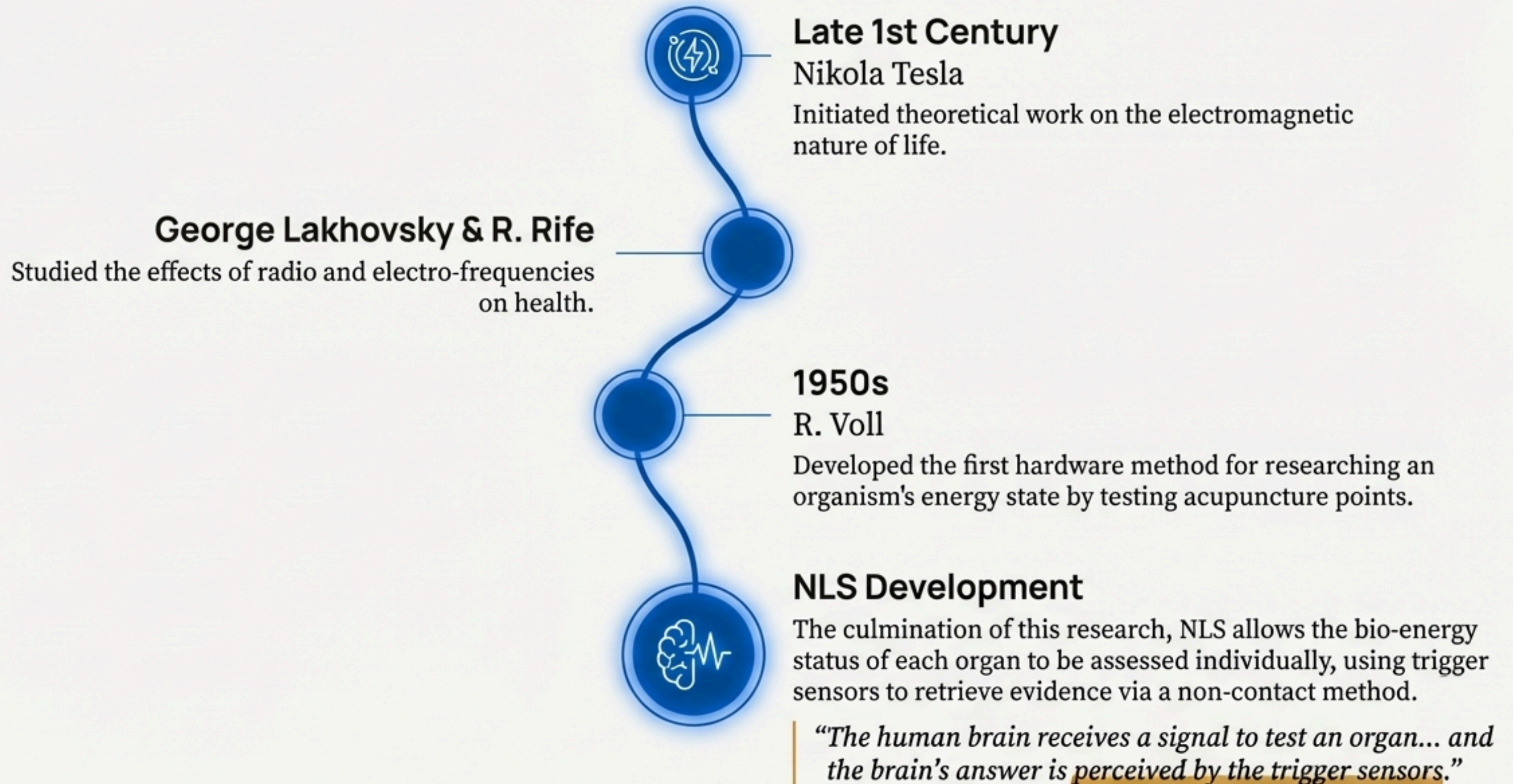

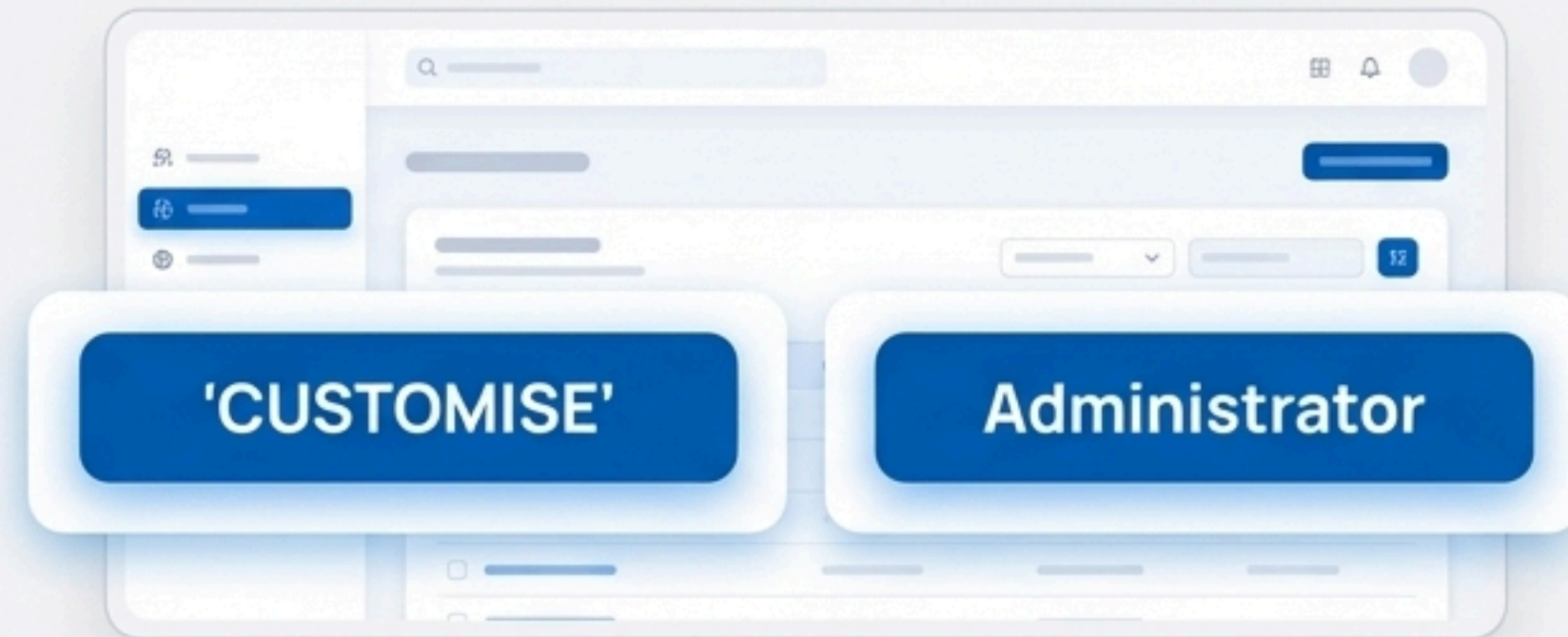

Initial Setup (via 'CUSTOMISE' button)

-  **Select Doctor:** Each physician can only see their own patients.
-  **Language:** Change the program language.
-  **Display Settings:** Options for bold font, colored pictures, and color-coding in the card index for at-a-glance functional status (Green: No changes, Red: Insignificant changes, Brown: Significant changes).

Practice Management (via 'Administrator' button)

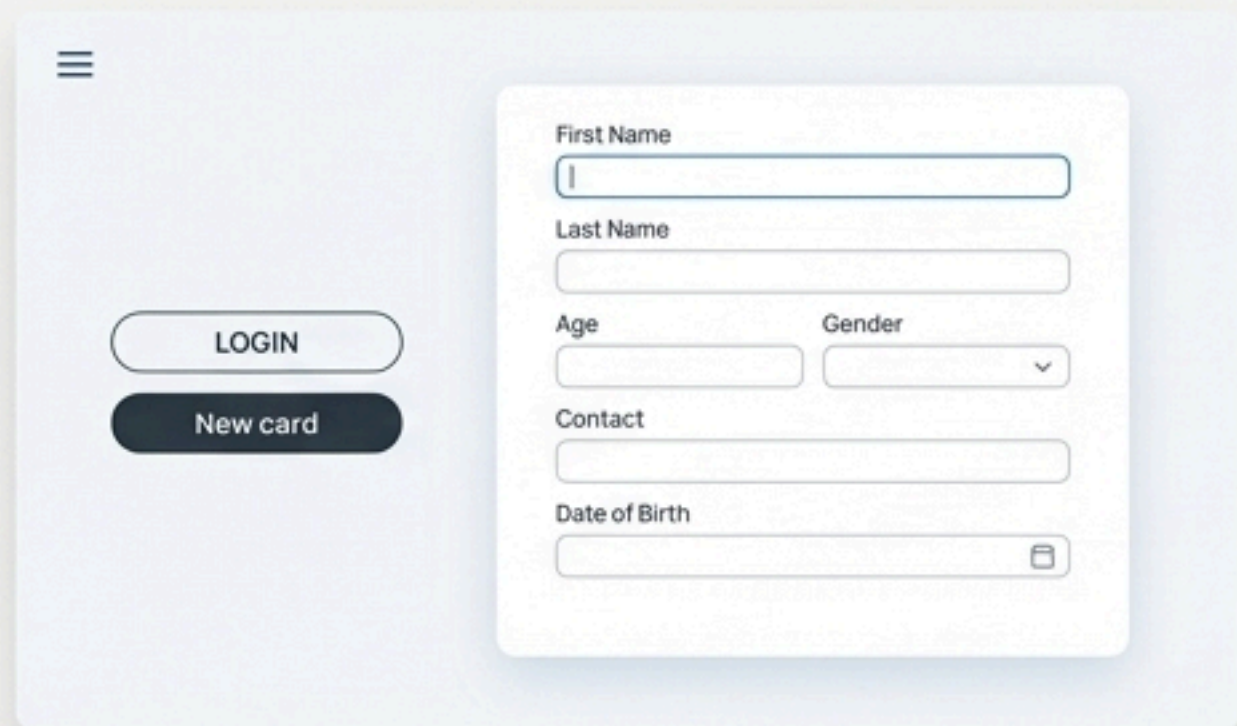
-  **Exchange Patient:** Securely transfer a patient's file to another doctor.
-  **Manage Physicians:** Add or remove doctors from the list.
-  **Reporting:** View research statistics for each doctor.
-  **Data Management:** Delete searches by date or remove a full patient card file.



Crucial Warning: If you delete a doctor from the list, all patient data processed by this doctor is deleted. Transfer patients first!

Onboarding Your Client: From New Card to Interactive History

Step 1: Create a New Card

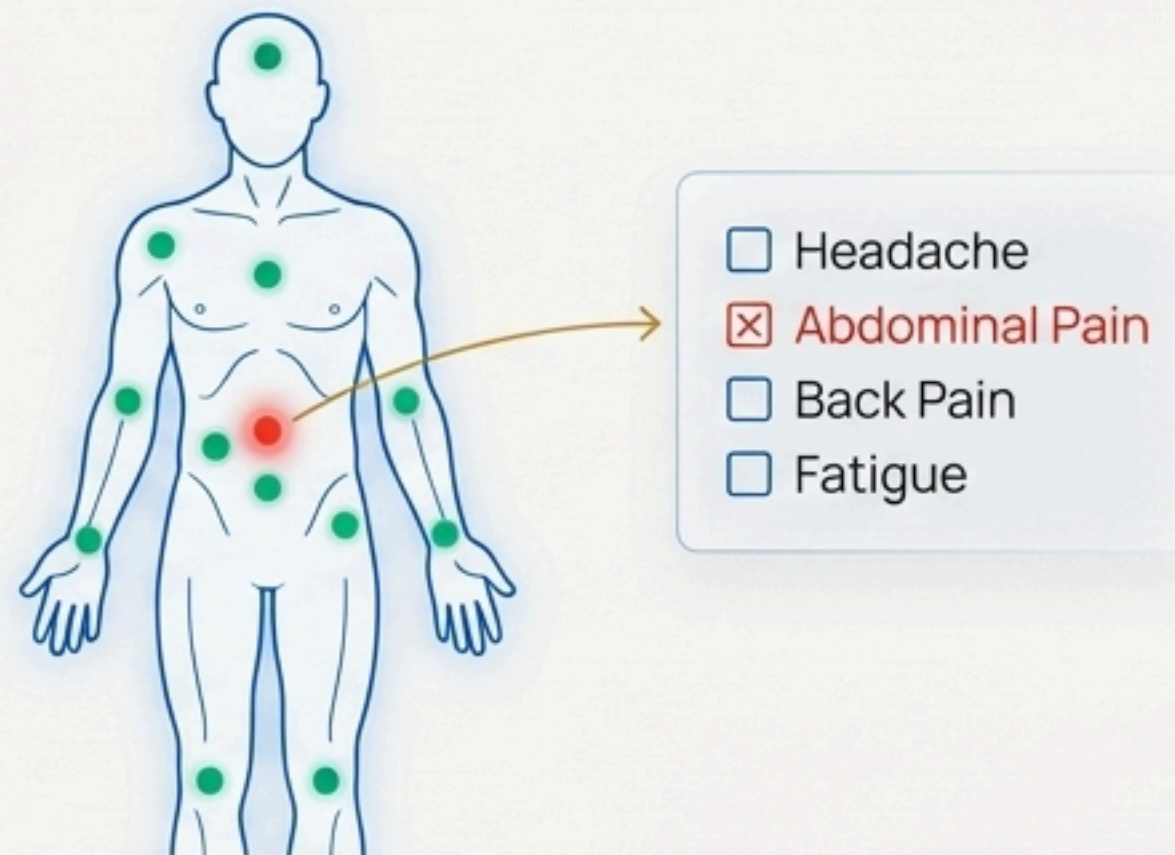

- * The practitioner clicks on an area of the body diagram.
- * A list of relevant conditions/complaints appears on the right.
- * As you select items, dots change from green to red, logging the client's input.
- * This builds a detailed, interactive health history before the scan begins.

1. Choose Investigation Type

- **Express:** General analysis without detail.
- **Normal:** General analysis with a more detailed look at structures with expressed functional changes.
- **Detail:** Time-consuming, detailed estimation of each biological structure.

2. Select Organs for Investigation

- **Manual Selection:** Click the square next to an organ to add it to the survey list.
- **Automatic Selection:** The computer suggests a number of basic systems for a primary examination.
- **Custom Sets (Case 1-5):** Use pre-configured investigation schemes for specific conditions.
- **Quick Selectors:** Connected organs, Everything, Deselect provide efficient list management.

Conducting the Analysis: The Live Scan Interface

User Control

The scan can be paused if necessary by clicking 'Pause/Resume'. Removing the headset automatically pauses the search.

Interpreting the Results: The 6 Levels of Energetic State



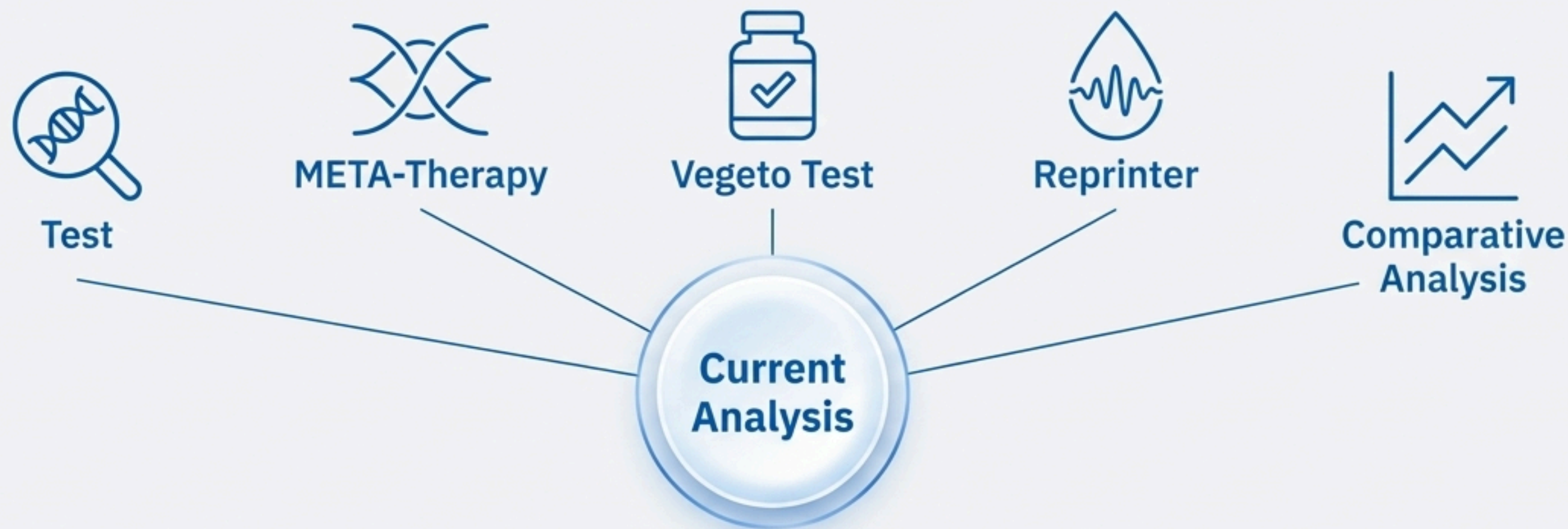
- **Level 1-2 (Light Yellow / Deep Yellow):** Mild changes, pre-clinical phase.
- **Level 3 (Red):** Upper limit of normal, functional changes.
- **Level 4 (Brown):** Pronounced changes.
- **Level 5 (Dark Brown):** Change in mean grade, clinical stage.
- **Level 6 (Black):** Strong decompensation, depleted adaptive reserves.



Practitioner's Note: This is very important! Since the NLS analysis method refers to energy techniques, the visual assessment of damage to the body belongs to the state of its energy! A patient with severe depression but no serious illness may show many levels of 4, 5, 6 due to their current state.

The Analysis Workspace: Uncovering Deeper Insights

After the initial scan, 'Current Analysis' is your primary workspace for in-depth investigation and therapy. From here, you can access the core functions that drive client outcomes:



-  **Test:** Access the extensive Etalon database to investigate potential root causes (pathologies, microorganisms, allergens, etc.).
-  **META-Therapy:** Perform classical bioresonant therapy to correct imbalances.
-  **Vegeto Test:** Test the effectiveness of external remedies and supplements.
-  **Reprinter:** Impart healing frequencies into a carrier matrix (water, sugar, etc.).
-  **Comparative Analysis:** Track progress by comparing scans over time.

Investigating Root Causes with Etalon Analysis

The **‘Test’** button opens the Etalon database, a library of frequency patterns. The system compares the organ’s signal to these patterns to identify potential influences.

Understanding Spectral Similarity

The number before each etalon indicates its spectral similarity to the organ being examined.

The Golden Rule: The smaller the figure, the closer the curves are.

Index < 0.425 (**Red**): High spectral similarity. This indicates a strong resonance. Depending on the etalon group, this can mean the presence of a pathology, a beneficial remedy, or a significant allergen.

Key Etalon Groups

-  Pathomorphology: Destructive processes.
-  Microorganisms & Helminths: Infectious agents.
-  Allopathy/Homeopathy/Phytotherapy: Remedies.
-  Allergens: Food, industrial, and environmental allergens.
